


U.S. Military / Police Assistance to Mexico, 2000-2016



U.S. Military/Police Aid and Arms Sales to Mexico, 2000-2014






Guns, ammunition, parts, explosives sold by U.S. to Mexico, 2001-2017










70% of guns traced from crime scenes in Mexico originate in U.S.

Figure 5: Top Source States for Firearms Seized in Mexico of U.S. Origin and Numbers Seized, 2009-2014








Mexico had more gun homicides last year than in any year on record, and will have more in 2018 than last year.


